


The objectives of the TRAECE project are:

THEME Smart Mobility Tool database provides the TRAECE Competence Matrix for digital use:

- to facilitate the organization of internships
- to promote high quality internships; automatically generate ECVET documents (Memorandum of Understanding, Learning Agreement (LA) and based on LA Mobility Certificate)
- to provide assessment instruments for the recognition of competences acquired in internships, training courses and parts of trainings throughout Europe (language, personal and social development, work process)
- to provide competences that can be varied or newly defined, e.g. if

- competences shift in the occupational field due to e.g. digitalization
- to provide the option to build up internal networks
- to ensure the option of setting up own learning outcome units
- to provide the possibility to integrate mobility data and copy mobilities
- to provide a broad variety of occupations (mechatronic, electronic, hospitality, trade and VET.40 (based on Industry 4.0 and Early Childhood Education and Care Matrix)
- to give barrier free access
- to have access free of charge
